

The Fashionable Sailor

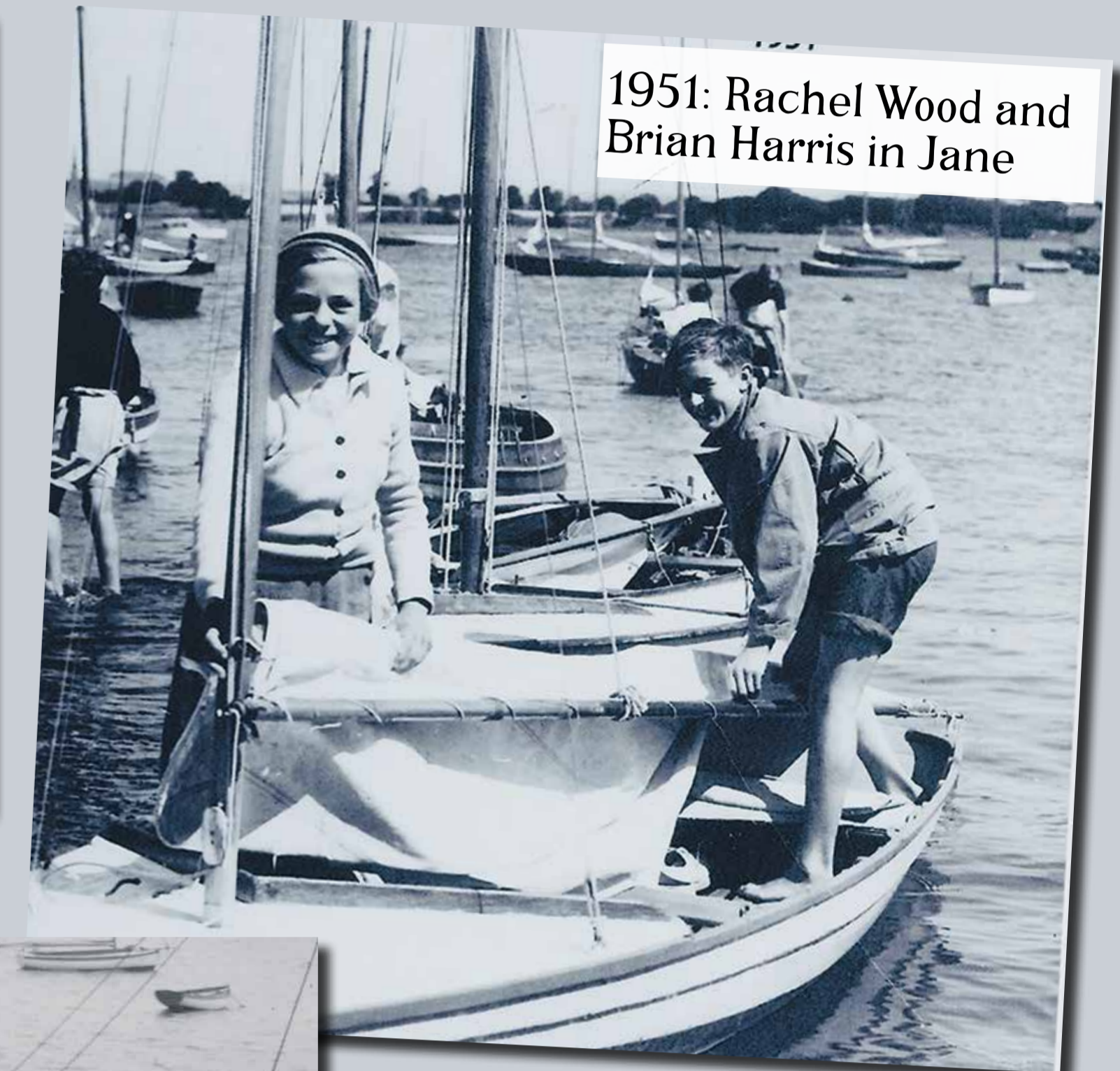
